COVID

We are regularly and routinely using the lateral flow tests with staff and pupils.

If your child has ANY of the symptoms of COVID, or is feeling unwell and you are concerned about the cause, please book an appointment for a test.

If your child tests positive, follow all the Government guidelines associated with the 10 day period of self-isolation. If your child is well enough, they can still engage in remote education.

Please inform us at the earliest opportunity if your son/daughter has tested positive for COVID.

IF YOU ARE IN ANY DOUBT ABOUT WHETHER OR NOT YOUR CHILD HAS COVID, PLEASE ARRANGE FOR A TEST. Do not allow them to mix with others and do not send them to school (when we return).

Vulnerable Children/Critical Workers


During a national lockdown, we can only accommodate vulnerable children/key workers. If you need clarification if your son/daughter is in this category, please click on this link:
