The school's standard admission number for Year 7 in September 2024 is 180. Pupils' admission into Year 7 is arranged by Lancashire County Council's South Area Education Office. If your child is in Year 6 you can now apply for their secondary school place online at: www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools. It is quick and easy to do and you will receive email confirmation of your application.

Parents who are initially unsuccessful in obtaining a place at the school may appeal (details of this procedure are available at the link above). You must apply even if you already have siblings in school. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your online application.

The closing date for secondary applications for September 2024 is 23:59 on 31st October 2023.

Late Bus Service

The late bus service allows pupils to stay late to complete school work or participate in after school activities. The late bus service from Broughton High School to Longsands, travelling through Fulwood, **leaves the school premises at 4.25pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays** at a charge of 60p per pupil per journey. Pupils are able to use their bus passes and return tickets.

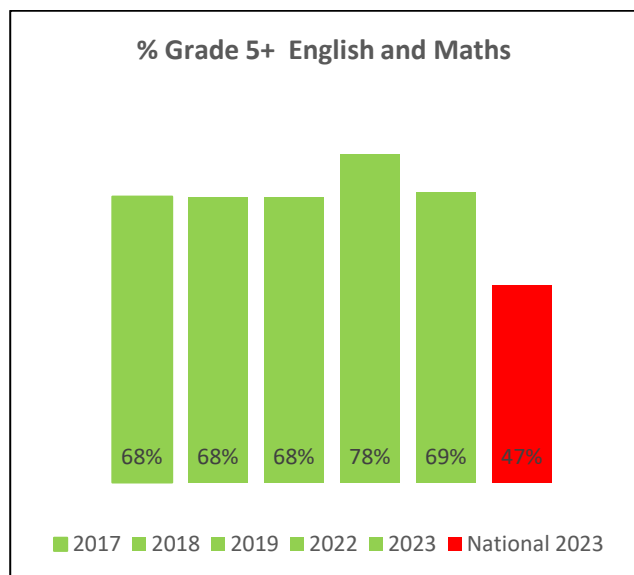
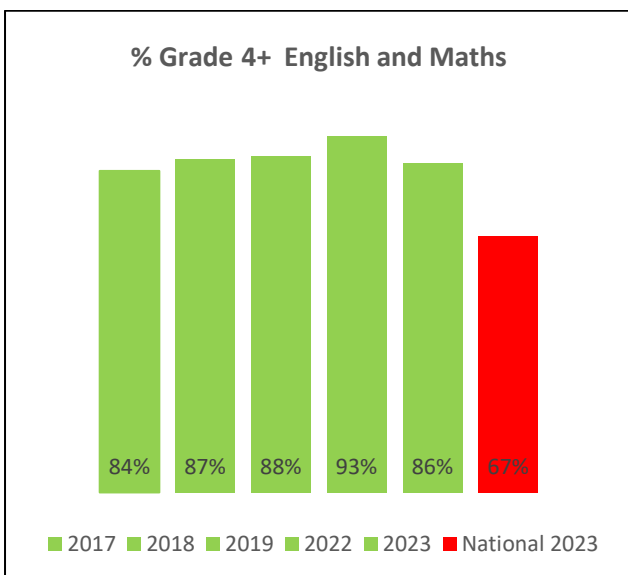

2023 RESULTS

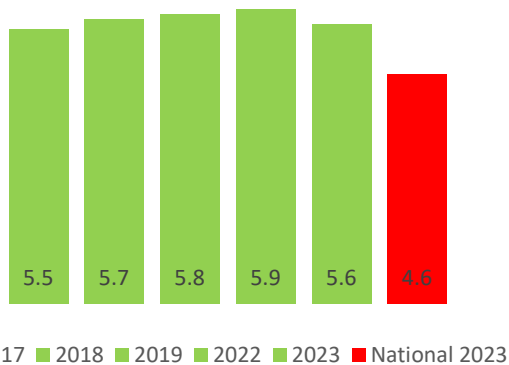

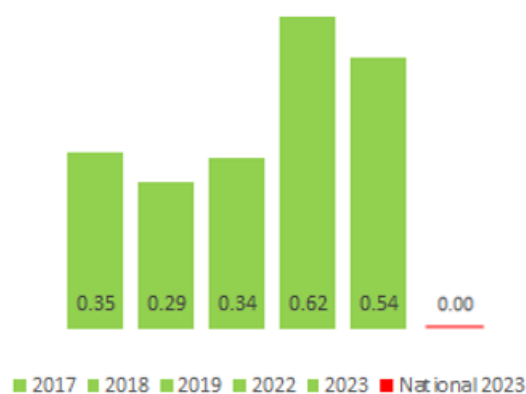
Our GCSE and vocational examinations results continue to significantly exceed national levels.
