## SENSITIVITY AND VERSATILITY



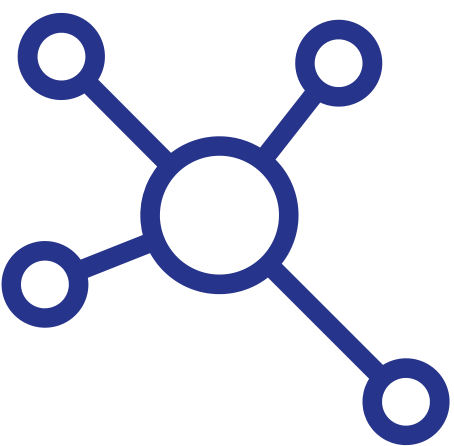
Look for layers of meaning

What is the literal meaning? What is being implied? Can you see any deep, more symbolic messages or ideas? Is it allegorical?



Look for significant vocabulary and phrases

What powerful language has the writer used? Why? Why at this point? What is the effect?



Look for links to things you already know

How is the text influenced by key contextual factors? Hint: texts are influenced by each other. Are there any allusions?



Look for the **BIG IDEAS** the writer is trying to explore.

Hint: profound universal, human ideas, like love, death, good & evil, ambition, power, conflict, adversity etc.



Interpret data, illustrations and charts carefully

What is the data showing? What can you infer from the data? Is it what you would expect based on your own knowledge?
