We do this by...



- 1. Locating our reading to make space a place. What are the clues? Climate, land or water, levels of development, foods, traditions...
- 2. Making connections between people and place. How are they linked? How have people adapted to the place? How are people changing the place?
- 3. Identifying causes. What are the processes? What is the sequence?
- 4. Looking through different lenses. Whose perspective are we seeing things from? How/why might people think about issues differently?
- 5. Making suggestions about future changes. How might things change? Can something be stopped? Should it be stopped?
