

READ LIKE A GEOGRAPHER

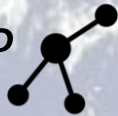
Our aim as we read like a geographer is to make sense of the world around us.

We do this by...



1. Locating our reading to make space a place. *What are the clues? Climate, land or water, levels of development, foods, traditions...*

2. Making connections between people and place. *How are they linked? How have people adapted to the place? How are people changing the place?*



3. Identifying causes. *What are the processes? What is the sequence?*



4. Looking through different lenses. *Whose perspective are we seeing things from? How/why might people think about issues differently?*

5. Making suggestions about future changes. *How might things change? Can something be stopped? Should it be stopped?*
