1. Your work in response to **assessment materials provided by the exam board**, including questions, past papers or similar materials such as practice or sample papers.

What evidence will be used to decide my grades?

2. Non-exam assessment (NEA) work (**coursework**), even if this has not been fully completed.

Technology, Art, Drama, Computer Science, iMedia, Engineering, Health and Social,

Travel and Tourism, Enterprise, Health & Fitness,

Hospitality & Catering and Food & Nutrition.

What evidence will be used to decide my grades?

3. Your work produced in **tasks** that reflect the specification, that follow the **same format as exam board materials** and have been marked in a way that **reflects exam board mark schemes**. This can include **substantial class or homework, internal tests and mock exams**.

What evidence will be used to decide my grades?

4. **Records** of your capability and performance over the course of study in **performance-based subjects** such as Music, Drama and PE.

What evidence will be used to decide my grades?

5. Records of each your progress and performance over the course of study.

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... will **not** be just your subject teacher deciding the final grade. The process will be a **collaboration** of all teachers of a subject, Heads of Department and Senior Staff.

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... there will be a **quality assurance** process in place to ensure fairness and consistency.

For example, if every pupil has to complete a **non-fiction piece of writing in English**,

then the marking of Mr Webster, Miss

Maloney, Miss Winter etc will be **internally**

moderated by all other English teachers.

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... you will be told by your teacher which assessment evidence you have already produced will be taken into account.

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... you will be told by your teacher when the assessment activities will happen, allowing you time to revise at home (more details to follow!).

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... all assessment activities (mini tests) will be in **usual classrooms**, under **'exam conditions'** within the usual one hour lesson.

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... you will only be assessed on
what you have been taught.

No surprises.

REASSURANCES. Good to know that ...

... if you have ANY questions,
you can ask your teacher.
