In-school resources



The main school website has important information for visitors, parents and staff including access to the careers calendar of events for the year. Each department has information about their careers provision.



The Broughton High School VLE has access to all of the resources that pupils use in school, and information about all careers events that take place. This is only accessible to pupils.



All pupils have their own Unifrog account. It is particularly useful in KS4. On Unifrog pupils can track the careers events they participate in, complete career related tasks and work on their employability through virtual work experience, CV tools and more. All Year 10 pupils use Unifrog to track their work experience.
